"Echoes of the Explosion"

Hughes & Runkle Buried Yesterday -- Grief of the Relatives...

The aftermath of the terrible explosion at the Hughes saw mill with the harvest of attendant sorrow is here, but those upon whom the crushing weight of death's reaping has fallen must continue to live on and perform the duties required of us all to eat, drink and asleep while the loved one lies beneath the sod, and the wind sighs a requiem over the inanimate forms that but a few short hours before were full of life and the strength of perfect physical manhood. But what is life but the sunset of a vanished day that transition from the glorious sunshine to the gloom of night. And this is but Ephemeral, for when the pall clears away, does not the glorious dawn of an everlasting day usher itself in unto those who have followed the teachings of an all wise Providence.

John Runkle and William Hughes, the victims of the saw mill explosion, were buried yesterday afternoon, a large crowd assembled at the respective places of burial.

The remains of Hughes were laid to rest in the Brassfield cemetery northwest of Springhill. The flesh on the right side of his face which was scalded and torn had already begun to decompose. Mrs. Hughes, of Lock Springs, mother of the deceased, was in the city yesterday morning on her way to attend the funeral. She is nearly 75 years of age and shows sadly the agony his death caused her.

Mrs. Mary Brassfield, a sister of the deceased, resides in this city and has been very sick for several days. Relatives were afraid to break the sad news to her, but finally did so and the shock nearly proved fatal.

Runkle's remains were interred in the Gibbons cemetery. The first great shock had passed away and Mrs. Runkle's great grief given place to the resignation of despair.

Notes for ELIZABETH SCHULTZ:

Elizabeth was Milton Hughes's second wife. Elizabeth's home was at Braymer, Caldwell County, Missouri, 25 or so miles from the Hughes home near Chillicothe. How Milton & Elizabeth became acquainted originally is uncertain. Possibly he had heard about her from a neighbor named Leslie Houston and then

went to Braymer to see her. Or possibly the first meeting occurred when some other neighbors, the Jim Dowells, had relatives visit them from Braymer who may have brought Elizabeth Schultz along. It is known that Milton was invited over to the Dowells and since he had a new buggy, he no doubt arrived there in grand style. Whether this was the first meeting of Milton & Elizabeth or not, it is definitely known that soon thereafter the Dowells and their guests were invited over to the Hugheses for supper. And quite a meal it must have been for the Hughes daughters, Mary & Martha, who were keeping house for their father since the death in 1882 of their mother, Mary Jane Varney Hughes, roasted a turkey & iced a cake for the occasion.

In regard to Elizabeth Schultz, it is remembered that her family were natives of Germany. Her father, John Schultz, was born in Mecklenberg-Schwerin on March 10, 1811, and died at Braymer, Missouri, on June 30, 1895 at age 84.

Elizabeth died in 1888. The arrival of their 5th child in December was the cause of Elizabeth's death in childbirth. The baby, a girl, also died and the mother & daughter were buried together in Shiner Cemetery two miles north of Braymer, Missouri.
